

BROWN-BEASLEY FAMILY CEMETERY

Flatrock/Brownville Road

Directions to cemetery: Travel US 31 North about 4 miles, turn left on CR 22, and go 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ miles, turn right on Flatrock-Brownville Road (a dirt road), and travel approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. The cemetery is on the left. It is located in Township 6 North, Range 12 East, Section 20.

This cemetery was first surveyed for *The Conecuh County Headstones, Volume II, Cemeteries East of I-65* by the late Mrs. Betty Lois Beasley Brown and Mrs. Jewell Brown, on 15th March 1981. Other notes were made by Mrs. Willene Johnston Whatley regarding two burials of Dewey Seymour Griffin & Nancy Jane Griffin; also, by Dan & Eugenia Brown in reference to some of the known but not identified markers; and Sherry S. Johnston, a Beasley descendant. * The graves for C.W. Beasley and Thirza Northcutt Beasley have been repaired by Sherry Johnston.
